General Rules

- 1. All Sables (Purebred, American, Grade and Experimental) are eligible for entry. There are two divisions:
 - 1. Purebred & American
 - 2. Grade & Experimental. Grades and Experimental must be at least 50% Sable and must meet Sable breed standard.
 - a. New this year: grade/Experimental entries will be combined with Purebred/American entries if fewer than 6 grade/Experimental animals are entered.
- 2. Each animal <u>must</u> have competed in at least one official ADGA show within the age year for which the animal is being nominated, and was awarded at least one of the following at an ADGA sanctioned show:
 - A. First or Second in an ADGA individual class.
 - B. Best of Breed, Grand Champion Senior, Reserve Champion Senior, Grand Champion Junior, Reserve Champion Junior

Photo Instructions

- 3. Required views are Standard Side Profile; Rear View of Udder and Legs; and Topline Rump to Withers taken from above rear quarters. Applications without <u>all views</u> will be rejected.
- 4. Photos should be submitted in JPEG format and must be at least 150KB.
- 5. No awards, ribbons or trophies in the photos. The handler must be cropped out above the shoulders. Photos sent with any identifying information in the photo will be rejected.
- 6. Photos must be taken during the year for which the entry is made.
- 7. Photos of All American and Reserve All American will be retained by ISBA for use in news releases, on our website, on our Facebook page, etc.

Entry Information

- 8. Submission of one completed Individual Nomination Form, required photos & copy of pedigree (from subscription reports or ADGA papers) for each nominated animal is required.
- 9. Entry deadline is Friday, December 22nd. No late entries will be accepted.
- 10. Entry is <u>free</u> to all ISBA members. Anyone can join ISBA at the time of nomination(s) if they are not a current member. Online membership must be paid before entries will be accepted.
- 11. **\$3 Entry Fee for Non-Members**
- 12. Any winning entry determined to be a misrepresentation of the animal will be removed, and a correction will be published online.
